- 1. How many instruments are in a string quartet? Four.
- 2. What instruments are in a woodwind quartet? **Two violins, a viola and a cello.**
- 3. Name the four instrument families: woodwinds, brass, strings, percussion.
- 4. Name one composer the quartet introduced in the presentation: Acceptable answers: Debussy, Mozart, Haydn, Shostakovich
- 5. What is the difference between the violin and the viola? The viola is larger than the violin, and has a deeper sound. The violin has strings G, D, A, and E. The viola has strings C, G, D, and A.
- 6. What does "vibrato" mean? Vibrate.
- 7. What are dynamics? Simply: the volume at which a pitch is played; loudness or softness.
- 8. Explain "call and response": **Two musical phrases where the second phrase is** in response to the first; a musical communication.
